

Summer Youth Employment Program 2019

It is time, once again, for the Lake County Summer Youth Employment Program! This popular program, funded by the Lake County Board, will provide meaningful work experiences for approximately 215 youth this summer.

Applications for the summer program will be available **Friday, February 1** and will be accepted until **Sunday, March 31 at 5:00 pm**.

Mailed applications must be postmarked no later than March 31 in order to be considered. We cannot be responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

Only one application, per person, will be accepted. Applications will be randomly selected by a computer program.

To qualify for employment, youth must be:

- Age 14 to 18 (by April 15) OR age 14 to 22 with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP)
- Attending middle school or high school
- Receive free or reduced lunch OR meet low income guidelines

Check the Job Center website after April 15 for the status of your application. Work opportunities for participants will begin June 17, 2019 at sites throughout Lake County. The program lasts approximately 6 weeks.
